Please note that a fine will be levied for any unauthorised parking.

#### Disabled access

#### Getting here by car

Keele University Campus is between Junctions 15 and 16 on the M6, and is just west of Stoke-on-Trent and Newcastle-under-Lyme. We are halfway between Manchester and Birmingham.

#### From the north

Leave the M6 motorway at Junction 16, signed A500/Alton Towers. At the motorway roundabout turn right onto the A500 for Crewe and Nantwich. The University is signed from here. At the next roundabout, go straight on the A500 (A531) and at the next one turn left onto the A531 (A525) for Keele.

After approximately 7 miles, turn right at the roundabout onto campus. From the motorway junction to Keele the journey time is about 20-25 minutes.

#### From the south

Leave the M6 at Junction 15 and follow the signs for the A519 into Newcastle-under-Lyme. The University is signed from the first roundabout. Two miles out of Newcastle, turn left at the roundabout onto campus. From the motorway junction to Keele the journey time is about 15-20 minutes.

#### Getting here by rail

The nearest railway stations to Keele are:

- Stoke-on-Trent (5 miles/8km)
- Crewe (12 miles/19km)

Buses and taxis are available outside both stations.

#### Getting here by air


Manchester Airport is nearest to Keele and is about 35 miles (56km) away.
